French-inspired silhouettes, subtle Art Deco touches, and globally influenced forms are elevated through sumptuous materials—ranging from walnut veneer and wire-brushed pine to burnished gold leaf and finely finished bronze hardware. Each piece resonates with a quiet grandeur, harmonizing the spirit of its original design with a modern sensibility that transcends fleeting trends.

Highlights from the Baker Reserve Collection include:

- **Round Tiered End Table** – A mainstay from the Barbara Barry Collection, the Round Tiered End Table features stylish reeding on the legs and top edge. A beautiful walnut veneer completes this versatile option for the living room or bedroom.
- **Scroll Cocktail Table** – First offered in the Thomas Pheasant Collection, the Scroll Cocktail Table has been reimaged for Baker Reserve with a wire brushed pine veneer. Spanning 60 inches, the table creates a stylish presence with its large scale and bold design sensibility.
- **Diamond Chest** – The Diamond Chest displays beauty in the details, including solid carved

doors in a diamond pattern, burnished gold leaf surfaces and a bold, red interior. It was first designed by Barbara Barry and now joins the Baker Reserve Collection.

- **Vienna Dining Table** – The Vienna Dining Table pairs a rectangular tabletop with a distinctive and expressive leg design. Crafted in rich walnut with polished bronze finish hardware, the table includes two extension leaves for added versatility.
- **Ming Cabinet** - The Ming Cabinet features architectural lines and ornamental details echoing Asian design influences. Crafted with walnut and a choice of metal finishes, this Milling Road Original offers ample storage, adjustable shelves and classically designed key insert hardware.
- **Cradle Wing Chair** - The Cradle Wing Chair reflects designer Laura Kirar’s personal sensibility, drawing from diverse influences to create new meaning. This quintessential Baker piece features a high back with delicate sloped arms and a gracefully cradled seat in the base.
- **Oval X Back Lounge Chair** – A signature piece from the timeless Barbara Barry Collection, the Oval X Back Lounge Chair has been refined with a slightly more delicate and slender appearance. Soft feminine movement defines the piece, with gentle curves crafted in fine walnut.
- **Sorbonne Chair** – The Sorbonne Chair is the ultimate French slipper chair: shapely, generously scaled and finished with a refined tapered leg. Designed by Paris-based Jacques Garcia for his namesake collection, the chair now joins the Baker Reserve Collection.
- **Neue Sofa** – Taking its name from the German word for “new,” the Neue Sofa is an ineffably modern piece with a slope arm, shelter wing and loose back seat. The sofa was designed by Laura Kirar for her signature Baker collection.

The Baker Reserve Collection debuts in October 2025 at High Point Market and will be available to the trade via showrooms nationwide.
